School Workforce Census: Advice for Timetablers

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Mapping Subjects to DfE Subjects

In SIMS .net all subjects need to be mapped to the appropriate DfE subject. You need to be a member of one of the following SIMS roles to perform this operation; **Curricular Manager, Senior Management Team or System Manager.**

1. Open SIMS .net
2. Select Tools | Setups | Subjects
3. Click Search
4. Select the first subject on the list
5. Click Open
6. Select the drop down for DFES (sic) Subject Code

7. Select the appropriate subject from the list
8. Click Save
9. Click Next
10. Repeat steps 6 to 9 until all subjects are mapped correctly.

Modern Foreign Languages

You should have your timetable set up so that a student's timetable shows the language they are being taught. If this language is not on the DCFS list then you should map it to the code **Other Language Subject**.

Science

There is a DfE subject **Science**. This should generally only be used to indicate KS3 Science teaching. Wherever possible you should use Biology, Chemistry or Physics as the subject code.

Technology

There is a DfE subject **Design and Technology**. You should not map any of your internal subjects to this subject. This may mean that you will have to restructure your timetable in the future to so that a student's timetable shows the specific technology they are studying. So at KS3 you should not use the subject Technology (possibly Te in your timetable) but instead have and use codes to represent Resistant Materials, Food, Textiles etc. You will then be able to map these to the appropriate DfE subjects; **Design and Technology - Electronics, Design and Technology - Food Technology, Design and Technology - Graphics, Design and Technology - Resistant Materials, Design and Technology - Systems & Control or Design and Technology – Textiles**

GCSE Vocational Subjects

Please also note that the following eight subjects apply to GCSEs in a vocational subject (or other vocational qualification) only – **Applied Art and Design, Applied Business, Applied ICT, Applied Science, Engineering, Health and Social Care, Leisure and Tourism, and Manufacturing**
