Software

- **Nova-T6** used by the vast majority of schools that use SIMS in Hertfordshire
- **Timetabler** used by schools that use Pearson E1 and some that use SIMS in Hertfordshire
- **Scheduler** used by schools that use CMIS in Hertfordshire

Timetable Planning software

Ideally you want a planning tool that integrates with your timetabling software to avoid duplication of data entry, both Nova-T6 and Timetabler are planning and timetabling tools. Many schools still use spreadsheets for this task, but it would be better to use a specialised piece of software that can be easily understood by others.

- **Nova-T6** used by schools that use Nova-T6 for their timetable
- **Timetabler** used by schools that use Timetabler for their timetable
