Health and Wellbeing	Learning outcomes
<b>Blast off into the future</b>	Students will be introduced to their future options: apprenticeships, employment, volunteering, further and higher education.
<b>Mission control</b>	Students will gain an understanding of the skills and attributes necessary for work by identifying, developing and discussing.
<b>Total eclipse</b>	Making effective transitions to secondary school. Students will be able to identify issues and coping strategies for their future transitions and reflect on their readiness for the next stage.
<b>Reach for the sky</b>	Students will be able to describe what aspirations are. They will explore what they want for their future.
<b>Stargazing</b>	Exploring inspirational roles in the media. Myth busting and widening knowledge of careers.
<b>Landing and exploration</b>	Subjects and careers. Students will understand the relevance of the subjects they are studying to their careers and future lives. They will be able to identify the range of skills they are developing in a variety of subjects.
<b>Relationships</b>	
<b>Rocket girl</b>	Challenging Stereotypes - to enable learners to challenge the stereotyping of career choices.
<b>Satellite transmission</b>	Teamwork, communication and problem solving. Students will be able to practise working as a team and develop employability skills.
<b>Living in the Wider World</b>	
<b>Mission to the moon</b>	Activity exploring the skills that make people enterprising
<b>My universe</b>	World of work and local labour market information. What's in my town? What jobs are there in my school?
<b>Spacecraft systems</b>	Researching careers using I.T.; - exploring careers and jobs websites
<b>Shooting stars</b>	Face to face focus on the real workforce. Students will gain an understanding of working life

<b>Landing zone</b>	Introduction to Youth Connexions Hertfordshire (how we help young people, where to find us)
<b>Looking into the future</b>	General overview of careers and world of work (including a quiz and guessing games)

<b>Space academy</b>	The importance of qualifications for the future
<b>Entering space</b>	Your first job (age restrictions, work permits etc.)
