P.6-7 Core and subject specific training broken down into terms the categories below:


Training for those working with children under 3: Specific training for those working with children under 3, including statutory baby training.

HCC FULLY FUNDED TRAINING



Hertfordshire County Council (HCC) is responsible for all schools and settings with children accessing Early Years entitlement funding. HCC commission HFL Education to support improvement of the quality of education to contribute to children's outcomes at the end of the Early Years Foundation Stage. They also provide support for all Early Years settings with serious incident support, safeguarding and transition.

HCC commission us, a not-for-profit company, owned by schools and the LA, to provide fully funded workshops and clinics to Early Years schools and settings. These are available throughout the year and include important sector updates.

TERMLY PVI WORKSHOPS

A fully funded workshop each term that includes relevant Early Years PVI safeguarding and sector updates and a focus on topics to help close the gap in Hertfordshire. This live webinar aims to provide support for those children who may not achieve as well as their peers. Offering settings and practitioners an opportunity to update their skills and knowledge to best support children's learning and development.

STATUTORY PVI TRAINING

SAFEGUARDING AND CHILD PROTECTION IN EARLY YEARS

Ensuring that practitioners understand their responsibility to keep children safe and to share concerns appropriately. EARLY YEARS DESIGNATED SAFEGUARDING LEAD (DSL) PART 2 - SAFE STAFFING AND CREATING A POSITIVE SAFEGUARDING CULTURE

This course provides information relating to staffing for the designated safeguarding lead (DSL) within the Early Years setting, including building a safe organisational culture, safe recruitment and how to effectively manage and monitor allegations against staff.

This session will help you to understand how to liaise with the Hertfordshire statutory children's services agencies and with the local safeguarding partners, including the Local Authority Designated Officer (LADO) and the Hertfordshire Prevent Manager. It is expected that the designated safeguarding lead has accessed safeguarding and child protection in Early Years training prior to attending this course.

TRANSITION

SUPPORTING SMOOTH TRANSITIONS

This is a fully funded project from HCC to support transition for children in Hertfordshire.

Some children may need particular help, including from other agencies, to ensure that their transition is as smooth as possible.

Research suggests that transitions are central to young children's development and emotional wellbeing. How the first transitions are handled can have a significant impact on a child's capacity to cope with change in the short and long term and impact on the progress they make from their individual starting points.

The Supporting Smooth Transitions toolkit is a suite of resources created by professionals working within the health and education sector that can be used to supplement current transition procedures within schools and settings including:

- Guidance around transition for leaders and governors
- Example policies
- Audit tools
- Proformas for gathering information and planning
- Editable resources
- Activities for children and families

The Transition Level of Need tool (TLonT) has been developed for schools and settings in Hertfordshire to share information about any potential needs to enable effective transition to be implemented for every child.




